We are now using a product called EvaluationKIT (http://www.evaluationkit.com/) which does everything EvalSys can do and then some. It's been a relatively easy transition and we've already used the new system for a Fall (2016) and Spring (2017) semester. We purge the data and start fresh for each end of semester run. • We export data from the system into a datamart and use JasperSoft for reporting long-term (beyond base reports provided in system for faculty use). • Questions we ask are chosen by the University overall, colleges, and departments. We use the hierarchy and allow some choices for questions from a predetermined menu; we do not allow individual faculty to add their own questions. • The system is centrally administered at VT by our Learning Technologies department.
