Step ID	Action	Expected Result
1.	Select Web Content link under the My Tools category	User directed to the Web Content Setup page
2.	Select the Options link	User directed to the Customize Web Content page with the following fields: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tool Title • Page Title • Frame Height (drop-down box) • URL • Open in new window? (Checkbox) • Update Options button • Cancel button
3.	Fill in the fields as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tool Title: Test Title • Page Title: Test Page • Frame Height: 600 pixels (default) • URL: http://www.google.com Select the Update Options button 	User directed to the Web Content page where the title should be Test Title and the specified URL should load a web page at the specified pixel size. In the tools listing, the tool should now be renamed to Test Page.
4.	Select the Options link	User directed to the Customize Web Content page
5.	Check the box next to Open in new window? Select the Update Options button	User directed to the Web Content page that should be blank
6.	Select the Home link	User directed to My Workspace page
7.	Select the Test Page link	A new popup window opens to the specified URL
8.	Close the popup window	Popup window closes and user should still be at the My Workspace page
9.	Select the Test Page link	A new popup window opens to the specified URL
10.	Select the Options link in the popup window	User directed to the Customize Web Content page
11.	Remove the checkmark from the Open in new window? option and select the Update Options button	The popup window refreshes with the web page still shown
12.	Close the popup window and select the Home link	User directed to My Workspace page
13.	Select the Test Page link	User directed to the Web Content page where the specified URL should be loaded
14.	Select the Site Setup link	User directed to the Site Editor page
15.	Select the checkbox for My Workspace and then select the Edit link	User directed to Site Editor page for My Workspace
16.	Select the Edit Tools link	User directed to the Site Tools page
17.	Select the checkbox for the Web Content tool. Then select the Continue button	User directed to the Add Multiple Tool Instances page with the following fields: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Title: source: Select: More Web Content Tools Continue button Back button Cancel button

18.	Enter the following information: Title: Test Page 2 source: www.yahoo.com Select the Continue button	User is directed to the Confirming site tools edits for My Workspace page where the newly added tool will be shown in Red
19.	Select the Finish Button	User directed to Site Editor page for My Workspace. The new web content tool will be shown in the tool list
20.	Select the Test Page 2 link	User directed to the Test Page 2 web content tool displaying the home page for yahoo. The tool title should also read Test Page 2
21.	Select the Home link	User directed to My Workspace page
