  - o Teaching with Sakai Webinar series was held November 21, 2011, from 4:00-5:00 PM, EST - Wikifolios, Wikiflections, & Exams for Online Participation, Understanding & Achievement, Daniel Hickey, Indiana University - Bloomington.
  - o Design Lenses meeting was held November 16, 2011, from 5:00-6:00 PM, EST - discussed prototype for OAE regarding structured feedback designs, specifically for annotations (included: collections, can be shared; same item can be in multiple libraries; discussed permissions- who owns the annotation - annotator or owner?; also discussed feedback)
